ELEMENTS OF RISK – Informed Consent

Transportation: School Bus to and from Alpine Lanes Bowling Alley and Wheelies Roller Skating Rink in Winnipeg

Educational activity programs, such as bowling and roller skating, which is being offered, involve certain elements of risk. Accidents may occur while participating in these activities. These accidents may cause injury. A few examples of the type of accident which one is at risk of having occur while bowling and roller skating are:

- 1: Falling
- 2: Sprained ankle/wrist/fingers
- 3: Bruises/scrapes

These accidents result from the nature of the activity and can occur without any fault on either part of the student, or the School Board or its employees or agents, or the facility where the event is taking place. By choosing to participate in the activity, you are assuming the risk of an accident occurring. The chance of an accident occurring can be reduced by carefully following instructions at all times while engaged in the activity.

If you choose to participate in bowling and roller skating on February 8th, 2017, you must understand that you will bear the responsibility for any accident that might occur. The Hanover School Division does not provide an accidental death, disability, dismemberment or medical expenses insurance on behalf of the students participating in this activity.
